Open Mail Ballots

Volunteers make up 3-4 person teams to remove ballots from envelopes and from secrecy sleeves, flatten ballots, to be tabulated. The process ensures the voter's right to a secret ballot.



Duplicate Mail Ballots

Volunteers work in pairs to duplicate mail ballots which cannot be read by the optical scanners. The ballot is then presented to the Canvassing Board for approval.
