# REQUIREMENTS TO REGISTER TO VOTE

- **You may register if you are:** A U.S. citizen and legal resident of the state of Florida; eighteen years of age (you may pre-register at 16 years of age).
- **When to register:** You may register up to 29 days before an election. Registration books will then be closed until after the election. You must be registered 29 days prior to the election that you wish to vote in.
- **Where to register:** The Elections Office, public libraries, driver's license offices and public assistance offices or [www.ClayElections.com](http://www.ClayElections.com).
- **How to change your address or name:** You can call our office to change your address within the state of Florida. All other changes (new registration, political party change, etc.) must be made on a Florida Voter Registration Application.
- **Voter Information Card:** You will receive your card about two weeks after the office receives your completed application and it is verified through the State. It lists your polling location, precinct number and districts. If you do not receive your Voter Information Card, please call our office.
- **Picture ID required:** You must present a photo and signature ID when you go to the polls to vote or you will have to vote a provisional ballot.
- **Mail ballots:** You may request a mail ballot by calling our office, by written notice, e-mail, in person or visit [www.ClayElections.com](http://www.ClayElections.com).
- **Early Voting:** Be sure to follow the local news or visit [www.ClayElections.com](http://www.ClayElections.com) for more information on Early Voting prior to each election.
- **Your voter registration status:** You can call our office or visit [www.ClayElections.com](http://www.ClayElections.com) to find out the status of your voter registration. Don't wait until the last minute to check your status!

## FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE

### What does it mean?

In a closed primary election, voters are limited to choosing candidates of their own party.

If you are registered in the Republican Party, you are allowed to vote for the Republican candidates, non-partisan contests and referendums.

If you are registered in the Democratic Party, you are allowed to vote for Democratic candidates, non-partisan contests and referendums.

If you are registered in a minor party or no party affiliation, you are allowed to vote in non-partisan contests and referendums in the Primary Election.

**Note:** A party change can be made on a voter registration application. A party change must be made prior to the end of the 29th day before an election.

**Note:** An new applicant who fails to designate a political party affiliation will be registered without party affiliation.

**Note:** If all candidates for a race are affiliated with one party and the decision will be made in the Primary Election, everyone who is registered to vote for that election will be allowed to cast a ballot. A write-in candidate would close the primary to only party-affiliated voters.
