A **Logic and Accuracy Testing** of the equipment used in the Recount will occur on **Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at 10:00 a.m.**

If the Secretary of State orders a manual recount in the U.S. Senate, the Florida Governor or Commissioner of Agriculture race(s), the Clay County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Friday, November 16, 2018**, to conduct the manual recount at **the Supervisor of Elections Office, 500 N. Orange Ave., Green Cove Springs, FL 32043.**

All recounts, if ordered, will be open to the public. Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal decisions made at this recount they will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose they need to ensure a verbatim record of the proceeding is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
