REGISTERING TO VOTE

- **You may register if you are:** An U.S. citizen and legal resident of the state of Florida; eighteen years of age (but you may pre-register at 16 years of age).
- You must be registered 29 days prior to the election that you wish to vote in. Registration books will then be closed until after the election.
- **Where to register:** The Elections Office, public libraries, the Tax Collector's offices, and online at [RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov](https://www.RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov)
- **To make changes to your voter information:** For address changes inside the state of Florida, you can call our office.. All other changes (name, political party, or signature, or new registration) must be made online at [RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov](https://www.RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov) or on a Florida Voter Registration Application.
- **Voter Information Card:** You will receive your card about two weeks after the office receives your completed application and it's verified through the State. You don't need it to vote. It's informational only and lists your polling location, precinct number, and districts. If you don't receive your Voter Information Card, please call our office.
- **Your voter registration status:** You can call our office or visit [VoterStatusClay.com](https://www.VoterStatusClay.com) to find out the status of your voter registration.

Vote by Mail: Request a Vote by Mail ballot over the phone, in person, or online at [ClayElections.gov](https://www.ClayElections.gov)

Vote Early: Vote at any of our seven Early Voting locations. Visit us online at [EarlyVoteClay.com](https://www.EarlyVoteClay.com) for dates, times, and directions to all Early Voting locations.

Election Day: On Election Day, you must vote at your assigned precinct. Visit [VoterStatusClay.com](https://www.VoterStatusClay.com) to look up your precinct and view your Sample Ballot.

FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE

WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

In a Closed Primary election, voters are limited to choosing candidates of their own party.

If you're registered in the Democratic Party, you're allowed to vote for Democratic candidates, non-partisan contests and referendums.

If you're registered in the Republican Party, you're allowed to vote for Republican candidates, non-partisan contests and referendums.

If you're registered in a minor party or no party affiliation (NPA), you're allowed to vote in non-partisan contests and referendums.

NOTE: A party change must be made 29 days prior to an election. A party change must be made on a Voter Registration Application or online at [RegistertoVoteFlorida.gov](https://www.registertovoteflorida.gov)

NOTE: A new applicant who fails to designate a political party affiliation will be registered with no party affiliation (NPA).

NOTE: If all candidates for a race are affiliated with one party, and the decision will be made in the Primary Election, everyone who is registered to vote for that election will be allowed to cast a ballot. A write-in candidate would close the Primary to only party-affiliated voters.
