Municipal Super Tuesday BOOK CLOSING

The City of Keystone Heights Election will take place on Tuesday April 12, 2016. A legal resident of Keystone Heights must register to vote by 4:30 PM on March 14, 2016 to participate in this Election. The polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. at the Keystone Heights City Hall. Robert Brown will be up against Hayley Gartee for Council Seat 1. Eligible voters may vote one of two ways:

- Vote By Mail – request a ballot from our office by visiting www.ClayElections.com or call (904) 269-6350. When returning a ballot, the postal standard for delivery of first class mail is 3-5 days for local mail delivery.
- Vote on Election Day – Keystone Heights City Hall, 555 South Lawrence Boulevard, Keystone Heights, FL 32656

Voter registration applications are available at any Supervisor of Elections office, public library, tax collector office, government office handling social services or online at www.ClayElections.com. Address changes can be made online at www.ClayElections.com, by calling (904) 269-6350 or by emailing mail@ClayElections.com, with birth date included. Name and party changes may be made by sending a signed, written statement to the Supervisor of Elections Office including birth date or voter ID number. Any updates, including signatures and political party affiliation, can be made by completing and signing a voter registration application and returning it to the Supervisor of Elections Office. All new applications received by mail must be postmarked by **Monday, March 14** in order to be valid for the Municipal Election.
