Ballots Mailed to Military and Overseas Voters For November 8th General Election

The Clay County Supervisor of Elections Office mailed/mailed over 1,900 ballots to absent military and overseas voters today for the November 8, 2016 General Election.

Absent military and overseas voters include all active-duty military, their spouses and dependents currently absent from their places of residence, and civilians who are U.S. citizens residing outside the United States.

Mail ballots for our domestic civilian voters will be placed in the mail on Oct 4th. State law requires domestic mail ballots to be mailed between 35 and 28 days prior to an election. Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active-duty military voters residing in Clay County.

Additional mail ballot requests will be fulfilled as received. Visit ClayElections.com to request a mail ballot. The deadline to request that a mail ballot be mailed is November 2nd by 5:00 PM.
