Clay County SOE Conducts LOGIC AND ACCURACY TESTING

The Clay County Supervisor of Elections Office performed its Logic and Accuracy (L&A) testing today, February 26, 2016. The L&A tests the county's voting and tabulating equipment to be used in the March 15, 2016 Presidential Preference Primary Election. Florida law requires the Supervisor of Elections to conduct a public test of the county's automatic tabulation equipment and reporting software prior to each election to ensure it is operating and recording accurately. The public logic and accuracy testing is performed on a random sampling of all tabulating equipment that will be used for mail ballots, Early Voting and Election Day.

Supervisor Chambless stated, "While performing our first L&A testing with the new equipment and wireless technology, it was exciting to see the efficiencies gained and the canvassing board's acknowledgement of the progresses made."
