Ballots Mailed to Military and Overseas Voters for March 15th Presidential Preference Primary Election

The Clay County Supervisor of Elections Office mailed/emailed a total of 743 ballots to absent military and overseas voters on January 29th for the March 15, 2016 Presidential Preference Primary Elections.

Absent military and overseas voters include all active-duty military, their spouses and dependents currently absent from their places of residence, and civilians who are U.S. citizens residing outside the United States.

Ballots will be placed in the mail on February 9, 2016 to our domestic civilian voters. State law requires domestic ballots to be mailed between 35 and 28 days prior to an election. Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active duty military voters residing in Clay County.
