## **Ballots Mailed to Military and Overseas Voters For August 30<sup>th</sup> Primary Election**

The Clay County Supervisor of Elections Office mailed/mailed over 1,400 ballots to absent military and overseas voters yesterday (July 14<sup>th</sup>) for the August 30, 2016 Primary Election.

Absent military and overseas voters include all active-duty military, their spouses and dependents currently absent from their places of residence, and civilians who are U.S. citizens residing outside the United States.

Ballots will be placed in the mail on July 26<sup>th</sup> to our domestic civilian voters. State law requires domestic ballots to be mailed between 35 and 28 days prior to an election. Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active-duty military voters residing in Clay County.

Additional mail ballot requests will be fulfilled as received.
