Skip the Lines on Election Day- Order Your Vote by Mail Ballot Today

The Clay County Supervisor of Elections Office will begin sending out Vote by Mail ballots on Tuesday, October 9th. There is still time to order a Vote by Mail ballot online at www.ClayElections.com or by calling our office at (904) 269-6350. Requests will be accepted until October 31st.

If you choose to Vote by Mail, please remember the following:

- Vote by Mail Ballots are sent to the address on file, please make sure your information is correct. Mail ballots cannot be forwarded. Update your information at www.ClayElections.com
- You must sign the Voter's Certificate on the back of the envelope. If your signature has changed, you may visit www.ClayElections.com to learn how to update it. Your signature must match the one on the Voter Certificate or your Vote by Mail Ballot will not count.
- Vote by Mail Ballots must be in the possession of the Supervisor of Elections Office by 7 PM on Election Day, November 6, 2018. Please allow sufficient time for them to be delivered to our office. Postmarks are not accepted.
- During the Early Voting period, October 26 through November 3, voters may drop off ballots at designated Early Voting sites between 8 AM and 6 PM. This is only during Early Voting. For locations please visit www.ClayElections.com
- On Election Day, Vote by Mail Ballots cannot be accepted at voting precincts. You may hand them in to our office at 500 N. Orange Ave., Green Cove Springs, FL 32043 or place them in the secure drop box out front. They must be delivered by 7 PM on November 6, 2018.
