## **Acceptable Forms of ID - Senate Bill 666**

Governor Scott signed Senate Bill No. 666 which adds three more acceptable forms of identification required at the polls. Every registered voter must present a valid picture and signature identification when voting in person. The photo and signature may appear together in one piece of identification or on two separate pieces of identification. The acceptable forms of identification include:

- Florida Driver's License
- Florida ID Card issued by DHSMV
- U.S. Passport
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Retirement Center ID
- Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID
- Debit or Credit Card
- Concealed Weapon License (**SB 666**)
- Government Employee ID (**SB 666**)
- Veteran Health ID (**SB 666**)
